WHEREAS complaint has this day been made before the undersigned, one of Her

Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said Islands, for that you **Randol Fawkes** (i) On 28th June, 1958, having lawfully entered upon the premises of the Bahamas Lumber Co., Ltd at Stafford Creek, misconducted yourself by behaving in an insulting manner cont. to Sec 162 (4) of Ch.69; (ii) Further being lawfully upon the premises of the Bah.Lumber Co.Ltd, remained thereon after having been lawfully required to depart therefrom cont. Sec. 162 (5) of Ch. 69.

THESE are therefore to command you in Her Majesty's Name to be and appear at

the Magistrate's Court at Nassau, N.P., on the **5th** day of **July**


19 58 at **10.30** o'clock in the morning before
